

## TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD

### RESOLUTION 02-08

Whereas, Jack M. Hines, Jr. is being honored for having served the Township of West Bradford for twenty-five years as its Township Manager;

Whereas, he has been a life-long resident of the Township and has served our community as both a professional and a neighbor;

Whereas, his noted professional contributions include: serving as the Township's Secretary, Treasurer, and Zoning Officer; founding and serving as the President of the Chester County Consortium of Managers; serving the Chester County Association of Township Officials as Chairman of its Legislative Committee; being an active member of the Association for Pennsylvania Municipal Management; serving on numerous municipal and County committees; and serving as an instructor for the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors through out the Commonwealth.

Whereas, his noted contributions as a neighbor to our community include serving the West Bradford Fire Company as both President and Fire Chief; serving the Thorndale Chapter of Rotary International as a member and President; serving as Director of the Gundaker Foundation; serving the Brandywine Conservancy as an Environmental Committee member and Chairman, and as a Trustee and Officer; and serving the Chester County Historical Society on its Board of Trustees;

Whereas, it should be further observed that during his tenure, West Bradford Township has evolved from a rural community of 3,000 residents having three employees to a suburban community of over 10,000 residents having a staff of twenty full and part-time employees;

Whereas, his most noteworthy achievements include: having implemented a Township park system that promotes the health and well being of Township families; having provided significant effort in working with and testifying before the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to bring forth meaningful laws beneficial to local governments and their citizens; having worked diligently to bring forth the closure and successful remediation of the

Strasburg Landfill Superfund Site; having provided a significant leadership role in teaching and promoting the principles of good government to the many municipalities throughout the State; having supervised the construction of a new municipal campus in order to better serve the long term needs of West Bradford Township residents; and assembling and leading an exemplary Township staff that now serves a much larger and diverse community;

Now, Therefore, be it and it is hereby resolved that the Township of West Bradford bestows upon Jack M. Hines, Jr., by virtue of his professional and community service, the honor, recognition and richly deserved congratulations for having achieved twenty-five years of accomplished service as Township Manager in the Township of West Bradford and offers best wishes for continued success in the years to come.
