

**TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD  
RESOLUTION 03-08**

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS FOR USE OF LANDS AND  
PROPERTY OWNED OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF WEST BRADFORD  
TOWNSHIP, INCLUDING PARKS AND OTHER FACILITIES.**

*WHEREAS, the Township does own and control various properties that are necessary to provide Township services including but not limited to parks; and*

*WHEREAS, the Township has established, over time, various rules and regulations for those properties; and*

*WHEREAS, regulations are established for the safe and convenient use of Township property and to preserve the integrity of property that is not intended for public access; and*

*WHEREAS, the various regulations should be memorialized in a single document; and*

*NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the following regulations are established for Township property, including parks and other facilities.*

**HOURS OF USE**

*PARKS- Parks shall be open between the hours of sunrise to sunset. At sunset all activities in all parks shall cease and all persons in the parks shall leave as soon as possible, except for specifically permitted activities and use of lighted facilities. In case of lighted facilities, park use shall cease when the lights for the lighted facilities go off. When a park is used for ice-skating or snow related activities the activities shall end at 10:00 PM and persons shall leave the park.*

*OTHER FACILITIES- Public access shall be available only to areas intended for public use or participation. Parking areas, vehicle access areas and other areas shall only be used during the hours from sunrise to sunset unless attending a Township related function or meeting.*

**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

*No person or group of persons shall bring any alcohol and/or intoxicating beverages or substances onto any Township property for their own use or for the use of any other person.*

**PERSONAL CONDUCT**

*No person shall improperly conduct himself or herself on any Township property so as to annoy any other person using the property.*

**DISPOSAL OF WASTE**

*No person shall dispose of any waste or garbage on Township property except in the receptacles designated for the respective purposes and when allowed by the*

*Township. No person shall dispose of or otherwise leave any dead animals or offensive matter of any kind on Township property. Specifically in parks, all persons using the park shall dispose of all waste and garbage in proper receptacles. No person shall dispose of any waste and/or garbage that is not generated during use of park facilities.*

#### **TOWNSHIP PROPERTY**

*No person shall damage, deface, destroy or remove any Township property including, but not limited to, signs, structures, equipment, natural growth and other material.*

#### **MOTOR VEHICLES AND CONVEYANCES**

*No person shall operate, stop or park any motor vehicle except on parking areas or other areas so designated for such use and at appropriate times. Nor shall any person operate any vehicle in a reckless or negligent manner on Township property. ATV's, motorbikes, minibikes, go-carts, hang gliders, or any other such vehicles or conveyances are prohibited on Township property.*

#### **FIREARMS**

*No person other than an officer of the law shall carry any firearm within the limits of Township property.*

#### **BUILDING OF FIRES**

*No person shall set or maintain any fire on any Township property except in stoves, grilles or fireplaces maintained for that purpose. Emergency fire bans shall be adhered to as may be required and stipulated in that emergency fire ban.*

#### **PETS/ANIMALS**

*Properly licensed dogs are permitted only when restrained on a leash. Persons exercising control of a dog shall be responsible for cleaning up and immediately disposing of any dog waste.*

#### **DESTRUCTION OF AUTHORIZED NOTICES; POSTING NOTICES**

*No person shall injure, deface or destroy any notice, rule or regulation posted at any place on Township property, nor shall any person post any notice or placard at any place within Township property other than by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township.*

#### **DANGEROUS EQUIPMENT**

**PARKS-** *No person shall use javelins, play golf, arrows, discus or similar athletic equipment dangerous in character unless under the direct supervision of an authorized playground supervisor appointed by the Township.*

**OTHER FACILITIES-** *No person shall use any dangerous equipment, conveyance or thing that may cause bodily injury to themselves or other persons. Areas not established by the Township for specific recreational facilities shall not be used as such.*

**SOUND EQUIPMENT**

*No person shall use sound amplification equipment on any Township property except by permission from the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township.*

**EXPLOSIVES AND FIREWORKS**

*No person shall have in his possession or set off any fireworks, incendiary or explosive devices on any Township property.*

**COURTESY PLAY**


*Persons using recreation facilities pertaining to basketball, volleyball, tennis and street hockey and like facilities are restricted to one (1) hour of use at any one time, except as otherwise permitted by the Township.*

**VIOLATION**


*Anyone violating these regulations shall be considered to be trespassing and creating a public nuisance and shall be subject to prosecution as may be applicable under the law. On any property that is posted with regulations, anyone violating the regulations is considered to have been given notice of being removed from the property and is therefore guilty of trespass. Likewise after verbal notice from a Township representative to cease a certain activity, a person is considered to have been given notice of being removed from the property and is therefore guilty of trespass. Anyone destroying or defacing Township property shall be subject to prosecution to the fullest extent of the law, including claim(s) for restitution for any costs to repair or replace damaged facilities.*




