Township Wins Statewide Award for Communications Efforts

West Bradford Township in Chester County has received an award for its entry in the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors' 45th Annual Township Citizen Communication Contest. The annual contest recognizes townships that have successfully communicated programs and activities to citizens.

West Bradford Township received first place in the Class 1 Newsletters category (for townships with populations over 10,000). Cranberry Township, Butler County, and Moon Township, Allegheny County, tied for second place, and Doylestown Township, Bucks County, received third place.

The contest attracted entries in eight categories, including printed, electronic, and most improved newsletters; annual reports; other publications; cable TV programming; social media; and websites.

All entries were judged on the usefulness of information presented and how well the information was communicated to township residents. Publications were also judged on their overall attractiveness and readability.

Judges for the contest included members of the association's Publications-Public Relations Committee, representatives from the Governor's Center for Local Government Services, and staff members of the *Pennsylvania Township News*, the association's award-winning monthly magazine.

The Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors represents Pennsylvania's 1,454 townships of the second class and is committed to preserving and strengthening township government and securing greater visibility and involvement for townships in the state and federal political arenas. Townships of the second class represent more residents — 5.5 million Pennsylvanians — than any other type of political subdivision in the commonwealth.
