Christmas Trees

Christmas trees and greens may be dropped off at both the Township Compost Site, 2020 West Strasburg Road, and the Municipal Campus, 1385 Campus Drive, beginning December 25 and continuing to January 31. The Compost Site is open on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 9am to 2pm and the Municipal Campus is open during daylight hours. Trees and greens may be dropped off at either location. Signs at the Municipal Campus and the attendant at the Compost Site will direct you to drop-off locations.

The trees are shredded into mulch; therefore you must remove all stands, ornaments and plastic bags from the trees. Christmas wreaths are not accepted.

The free mulch from the shredding is available throughout the year at the Compost Site. Wood mulch helps to slow weed growth, and leaf mulch provides a nutrient-rich soil amendment for planting beds. Residents are responsible for loading mulch into their vehicles.

We do our best to keep these drop-off facilities as neat and clean as possible and ask for your assistance in this endeavor. Please realize that drop-off areas are monitored and anyone caught dumping trash or other material is subject to fine.
