

**WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE 08-05**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
THE MUNICIPAL WASTE AND RECYCLABLE COLLECTION
ORDINANCE 08-04.**

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Bradford, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1 – Add to Section 3 A

k. Each residential unit must participate in the West Bradford Township municipal waste collection system as provided in this Ordinance. Mobile home parks or multi-family housing that is not part of the West Bradford Township municipal waste collection system must have a separate municipal waste collection and disposal system.

SECTION 2 – Add to Section 4 C

h. Each residential unit must participate in the West Bradford Township municipal recycling system as provided in this Ordinance. Mobile home parks or multi-family units that are not part of the West Bradford Township municipal recycling system must have a recycling program in accordance with this Ordinance. Residential units in a mobile home park or multi-family housing must participate in the program that is provided for them.

SECTION 3 – Severability Clause

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


SECTION 4 – Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective five days following adoption.


