Greenway Tools and Pilot Projects**

As you know, the Concept Plan for the Brandywine Creek Greenway was completed in June, 2012 and is available to view online at [www.brandywineconservancy.org/greenway](http://www.brandywineconservancy.org/greenway). The eight West Branch municipalities are now in the process of reviewing and finalizing the West Branch Addendum.

Phase II, Strategic Action Plan preparation, is well underway. Many of you attended two evening presentations in February and March of this year focused on regulatory and non-regulatory tools to keep the greenway green. The next step is to meet with representatives from each of the twenty-four greenway municipalities over the coming months. During the meetings we will review and discuss greenway tools that could be introduced or better utilized and generate a list of possible pilot projects based upon the Concept Plan and Addendum. The following documents are enclosed for review prior to the meeting:

1. Goals and Objectives (listed in the Concept Plan and Addendum)
2. Draft Concept Map
3. Regulatory Tools handouts and checklist
4. Non-Regulatory Tools handouts and checklist
5. Pilot Project Examples
