In just two years since West Bradford Township (WBT) residents approved the Open Space referendum, 332.34 acres have been conserved for open space. These newly preserved acres represent 3% of West Bradford's total township acreage. Interest among landowners to conserve their land is high. The Township is in discussions with many landowners who understand the benefits of conserving open space for their families and the entire community and want to leave an enduring legacy for generations to come.
