Watershed Protection Tip NATURESCAPE THIS SPRING

Naturescaping returns native plants to your yard. Naturescaping conserves water and energy, reduces pollution, and creates wildlife habitat. This approach to property maintenance uses native plants that are naturally resistant to local pests and diseases. Once established, these plants can survive on rainwater alone. You can naturescape areas by replanting sections of lawn with a wildflower meadow, a hummingbird and butterfly garden, or plants and trees selected for seeds, fruit, and nectar.
