REVIEW / APPROVE MINUTES:

Draft minutes for the August 3, 2020 meeting prepared by John Braxton, Secretary, were approved with minor revisions.

UPDATES FROM OTHER COMMITTEE MEETINGS:

Abbie Kessler gave an update on the most recent Historical Commission meeting where the Commission discussed a zoning exception for historical buildings in the township, as well as plans to update the Historic Resource Inventory to know where the zoning exception applies. There will be a public meeting in November for anyone who is interested and may own one of these properties.

OPEN SPACE, RECREATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES (OSRER) PLAN:

Meg Kramer gave an update on the OSRER Plan. The Board of Supervisors have confirmed an Advisory Committee for the project and are in the process of scheduling the first kick-off meeting. Bob Portnoy is the representative from the LP&SC.

BRANDYWINE CONSERVANCY SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES ASSESSMENT (SCA) FOLLOW-UP:

Justin Yaich reached out to other township supervisors and heard back from East Brandywine Township. They are ensuring their township's permits are reasonable and are incentivizing use of solar and other renewable energy. Justin plans on meeting with Jim Lucas, WBT's Codes Officer, to review the township's codes as they relate to this topic.

READY FOR 100 RESOLUTION:

After a brief discussion and slight revisions, committee members passed a motion to send the Ready for 100 Resolution on to the Board of Supervisors.

WBT ENERGY AUDIT UPDATE:

Scott Andress updated committee members on information available about sources of energy used in West Bradford Township.

Cheryl Wanko, LP&SC Sustainability Subcommittee member, gave an update on results from the township sustainability survey.
